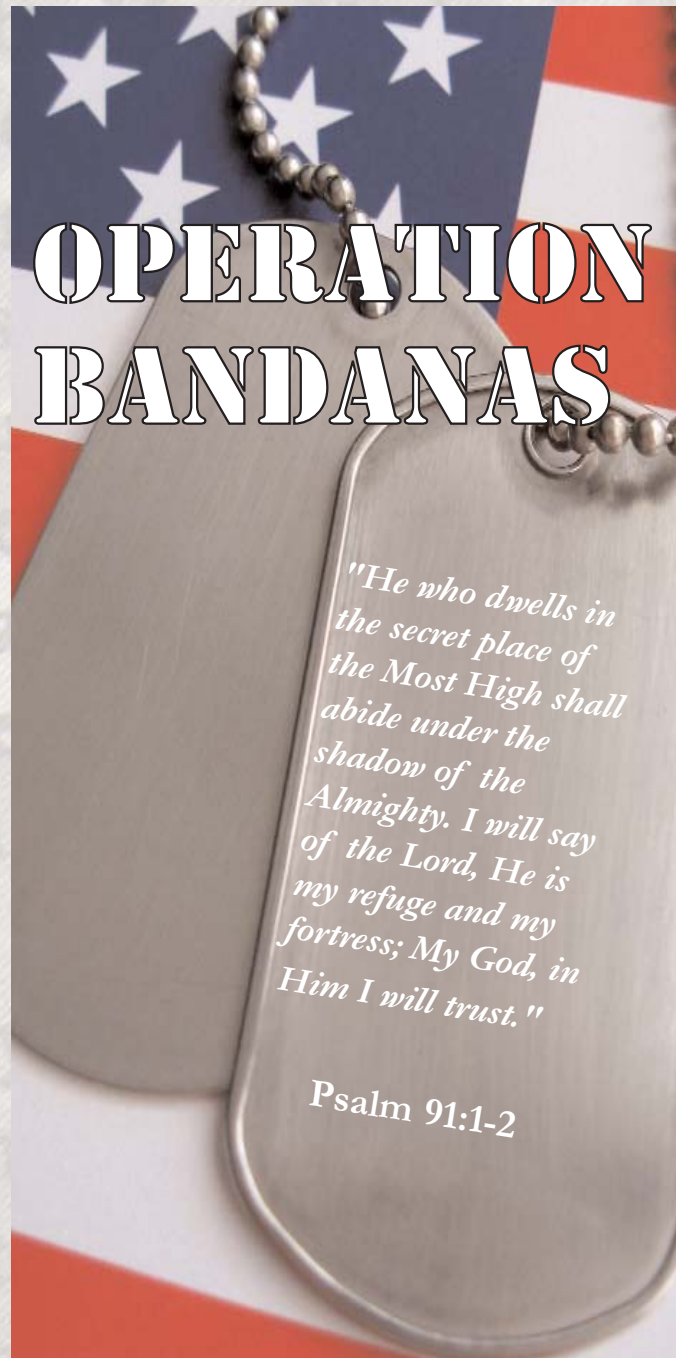

# OPERATION BANDANAS

## DELIVERANCE

## WHAT:

What started as an effort to provide Ft. Bragg, N.C. with Psalm 91 bandanas has now expanded to covering all of our military, deployed and deploying to Iraq and Afghanistan, with this "Soldier's Psalm" camouflage bandana.

Chaplains are distributing them to our troops, in addition to soldiers and Commanders who are personally requesting them. Tens of thousands have been sent out.

Not only are the bandanas an inspired tool for spreading God's Word, but they are useful also to cover the face from the sand and dust; as a sweat rag; and as an emergency wrap for a splint, sling, or tourniquet.

## HOW:

1. Donations from grateful, generous citizens, churches, organizations, companies, and friends and families of our military.
2. Involve/mobilize your church in providing these for our troops.
3. Spread the word about this mission to others in your community (i.e. churches, organizations, individuals).
4. Promote OpBan for a period of time at your church, then take up an offering to provide Psalm 91 bandanas.
5. Promote and plan a Patriotic event, (i.e. Memorial Day, July 4th, Veterans Day) and give to Operation Bandanas in honor of and in memory of those
